A list of competitors and event entered will be posted on the web site and in the rink. Please check this and advise BEFORE the Draw if you are in the wrong competition. If after the draw you are in the wrong competition you may not be able to skate and the fee will not be refunded.

All competitors must be members of Murrayfield Ice Skating Club members or patrons of Murrayfield Ice Rink or Murrayfield Skating School and Academy.

You do not need to have a private coach to enter these competitions.

Competitions are open BOTH to Club Members and Non-Members who are patrons of Murrayfield Ice rink or Murrayfield Ice Skating School and Academy. Competitions 1-16 are for under 18 years of age and 17 - 20 are for 18 years of age & over. All skaters must meet the entry requirements for the competition (standard at closing date) they are entering. All the competitions are mixed (male & female) Competitors should try to link each element with steps and arm movements

1. LEVEL ONE COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level 1 but not level 2.

- Requirements:
1. Forward skating on alternate feet (minimum of 6 steps)
 2. Snowplough Stop.
 3. Skate Backwards (minimum of 6 steps)

2. LEVEL TWO COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level 2 but not level 3.

- Requirements:
1. Forward skating on alternate feet. (Minimum 10 steps).
 2. Two footed gliding on a curve.
 3. Forward and Backward sculling (4 of each)
-

3. LEVEL THREE COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level 3 but not level 4.

- Requirements:
1. Forward One foot Glide in a straight line (Right & Left Feet) followed by a T Stop.
 2. One Forward inside curve (Right & Left Feet).
 3. Backwards skating on alternate feet and 2 foot glide.(Right & Left)

4. LEVEL FOUR COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level 4 but not level 5

- Requirements:
1. Forward Chasses (Minimum 4 in each direction)
 2. One Forward outside curve (Right & Left Feet)
 3. Backward Skating with backward snowplough stop
-

5. LEVEL FIVE COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level 5 but not level 6.

- Requirements:
1. Forward cross overs (minimum 4 in each direction- clockwise & anti clockwise)
 2. Backward one foot glide (Right & Left Feet)
 3. Forward Two foot slalom
-

6. LEVEL SIX COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level 6 but not level 7.

- Requirements:
1. Backward Chasses (Minimum 4 on each foot)
 2. Forward outside three turns in both directions.
 3. Forwards inside curves (Minimum 2 on each foot)

7. LEVEL SEVEN COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level 7 but not level 8.

- Requirements:
1. Backward crossovers (Min 4 in each direction clockwise & anti clockwise)
 2. Forward outside curves (Minimum 2 on each foot)
 3. Forward drag
-

8. LEVEL EIGHT COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level 8 but not level 9.

- Requirements:
1. Forwards inside mohawks. (ONE in each direction)
 2. Back crossovers with sustained back outside edge (Right & Left)
 3. Bunny hop and drag
-

9. LEVEL NINE COMPETITION

Standard: Must hold Skate UK Level 9 but not level 10.

- Requirements:
1. Back outside edges (Minimum 4)
 2. Forward crossrolls (Minimum 4)
 3. Forward Spiral
-

10. LEVEL TEN COMPETITION

Standard: Must hold Skate UK Level 10 but no higher.

- Requirements:
1. Forward crossovers in a figure of eight
 2. Simple Step sequence
 3. Three jump
- Above should be performed using no more than ½ ice
-

11. BRONZE STAR COMPETITION

Standard: Must hold Skate UK Level Bronze Star but no higher

- Requirements:
1. Forward Spiral
 2. Salchow Jump
 3. One foot spin
- To be linked with steps and arm movements using no more than ½ ice
-

12. SILVER STAR COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level Silver Star but no higher

- Requirements:
1. Toe Loop jump
 2. One foot spin (with correct entry and exit)
 3. Backward spiral
 4. Step sequence
- To be linked with steps and arm movements using no more than ½ ice
-

13. GOLD STAR COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level Gold Star but no higher and **must not have skated in an 'open' competition.**

- Requirements:
1. One minute 30 secs programme to music of skaters choice to include
Skaters must perform a well-balanced programme with linking steps, consisting of
 - (a) A maximum of 3 jump elements including
 - Different single jumps only, excluding axel.
 - NO combinations or sequences are permitted
 - (b) A maximum of 2 spins of different ISU abbreviations.
 - Basic position spins (of different ISU abbreviations) only are allowed with no change of foot and no change of position. (Min 3 revs) Difficult variations will only be counted if executed before or after 2 revolutions in the basic spin position. In Spin elements only features up to Level 1 will be counted.
 - (c)
 - A maximum of 1 Step Sequence (min 75% ice coverage required)

14. GOLD STAR+ (open) COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level Gold Star but no higher and skated in a free skating 'open' competition.

- Requirements:
1. One minute 30 secs programme to music of skaters choice to include
Skaters must perform a well-balanced programme with linking steps, consisting of
 - (a) A maximum of 3 jump elements including
 - Different single jumps only, excluding axel.
 - NO combinations or sequences are permitted
 - (b) A maximum of 2 spins of different ISU abbreviations.
 - Basic position spins (of different ISU abbreviations) only are allowed with no change of foot and no change of position. (Min 3 revs) Difficult variations will only be counted if executed before or after 2 revolutions in the basic spin position. In Spin elements only features up to Level 1 will be counted.
 - (c)
 - A maximum of 1 Step Sequence (min 75% ice coverage required)

15. National Level 1 COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Level 1 Elements or Free but not Level 2 Elements or Free (National Tests not UK Skate)

- Requirements:
1. One minute 30 secs programme to music of skaters choice to include
Skaters must perform a well-balanced programme with linking steps, consisting of
 - (a) A maximum of 4 jump elements including
 - Any single jumps may be executed, excluding axel
 - A maximum of 1 jump combination or sequence consisting of only 2 single jumps, excluding axel
 - No jump may be executed more than twice in total.
 - (b) A maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin with no change of position.
 - The spin combination can be executed with a change of foot and a minimum of six (6) revolutions or without a change of foot with a minimum of four (4) revolutions
 - The spin with no change of position can be executed with a change of foot and a minimum of six (6) revolutions or without a change of foot and a minimum of four (4) revolutions
 - In both spins flying entries are allowed.
 - In spins with no change of position, difficult variations will only be counted if executed before or after 2 revolutions in the basic spin position. If a change of foot is executed this requirement only applies to the forward spin.
 - (c) Maximum of 1 step sequence utilising the full ice surface
In all elements subject to levels only features up to level 2 will be counted.

DANCE COMPETITION

16. PATTERN DANCE COMPETITION

Standard: Must hold Skate UK Level 1 but no higher than Gold star (no National Dance Tests. Field moves are OK)

Requirements: 1. Palais Glide

Skated on Full ice. Two skaters, on ice at the same time, each starting at opposite ends of the rink.

ADULTS COMPETITIONS

These Competitions are for both NON MEMBERS & MEMBERS 18 years of age and over.

17. ADULTS SKATE UK LEVEL 1 TO 5 INCLUSIVE COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level 1 but no higher than Skate UK Level 5

- Requirements:
1. Forward Chasses (both directions)
 2. Forward One foot Glide in a straight line (Right & Left Feet) followed by a T Stop.
 3. Skate Backwards (minimum of 6 steps)

18. ADULTS SKATE UK LEVEL 6 TO 10 INCLUSIVE COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold Skate UK Level 6 but no higher than Skate UK Level 10 and must **NOT** have skated in an 'open' competition.

Requirements: On half-ice perform the selected elements with linking footwork;

1. Backward crossovers (both directions)
 2. Forward inside Mohawks (ONE in each direction)
 3. Forward drag
 4. One foot or two foot spin

19. ADULTS STAR COMPETITION

Standard: Must Hold A Skate UK Level Bronze, Silver or Gold Star but no higher and must not have skated in a free skating 'open' competition.

Requirements: 1 One minute 30 secs programme to music of skaters choice to include

Skaters must perform a well balanced programme with linking steps, consisting of

- (a) A maximum of 4 jump elements including
 - Any single jumps may be executed, excluding axel
 - A maximum of 1 jump combination or sequence consisting of only 2 single jumps, excluding axel
 - No jump may be executed more than twice in total.
 - (b) A maximum of 2 spins of different ISU abbreviations.
 - Basic position spins (of different ISU abbreviations) only are allowed with no change of foot and no change of position. (Min 3 revs) Difficult variations will only be counted if executed before or after 2 revolutions in the basic spin position. In Spin elements only features up to Level 1 will be counted
 - (c) Maximum of 1 choreographic step sequence covering 50% of usual pattern.

ADULTS DANCE COMPETITION

20. PATTERN DANCE COMPETITION

Standard: Must hold Skate UK Level 1 but no higher than Gold star (no National Dance Tests. Field moves are OK)

Requirements: 1. Palais Glide

Skated on Full ice. Two skaters on ice at the same time, each starting at opposite ends of the rink.
