The **Murrayfield Ice Skating Club** is a skating club which has taken an active part in all levels of ice skating since it was founded in 1957. As well as encouraging competitive skating by organising and running competitions the club helps non skaters by running group tuition classes.

The Club sessions are on Sundays from 10.00am to 12.00noon. During this time you can learn to skate and dance. In addition to the group tuition sessions many of the "Older" Club members will be only too willing to give you some assistance - all you need to do is ask. As well as the General skating periods there are two 15 minute dance intervals which you can either participate in or have a rest and watch. Where as it is recommended that you have some level of skating ability (e.g. grade test or UK skate level 3 or 4) the club is keen to encourage all levels of skating and is particularly keen to encourage family participation at all levels.

### TRY BEFORE you JOIN

You are welcome to skate at the Club up to four times before you are required to join. Even after that you do not need to join but you will have to pay a higher weekly fee to skate at the Club (once your application form has been handed in you pay the same as Club members). There are three 30 minute group tuition sessions taken by one of the rinks coaches on behalf of the Club. 'Learn a Dance'(changes monthly) at 10.00 the second session, for levels 3 to 10, at 10.45 and the third an edge class at 11.30. See the notice board for an idea of what is in each session.

**MEMBERSHIP - SKATING** - Basically there are two membership categories **Skating** and **Non Skating**. If you want to skate at the club, compete in the club competitions or skate under the Clubs name in open and national competitions you need to be a skating member. **FULL** member for those over 16 or **Student** if in full time education and **Under 16**. The basic difference is that the under 16's/students have a lower membership fee but are not able to vote at Club meetings. The 'Under 16's' & 'over 60 's' have a lower weekly entry fee to skate at club sessions than the Student & Full Members'.

Associate Skating (visitor) is a category of membership only available for those who live further away and cannot manage to attend the Club sessions very often and do not skate at Murrayfield Ice Rink on a regular basis. Associate Skating members can attend **up to 5 club sessions** at the member price before either paying the higher guest rate or upgrading their membership category by paying the difference between the Associate Skater fees & the Full or Junior membership fees.

**NON SKATING/SPECTATING - Associate members** are non skating members who like to spectate and be part of an organised group or like attending the various social outings the Club organises. (Associates also pay less for spectating at Club sessions). Ideal for parent or guardians.

A **recreational member** is a NON Skating member of the Club who is interest in promoting the Club and actively helps regularly at Club sessions (doing the NON Skating work). You **MUST** first join as an Associate member and then request to become a Recreational member (they have the same benefits as Full members).

All categories of membership are kept up to date of the Clubs Competitions, social events and benefit from reduced entry to Club run skating events. Note only Full & Recreational members are able to vote at General Meetings

The Club encourages parents or an adult guardians to attend the club sessions if the skating child is under 10years of age. To reduce the cost each week it is recommended the parent/guardian joins as an associate member. The club currently waves the joining fee for new associate members.

**JOINING THE CLUB** is quite easy. Simply complete the details on the reverse of this form, ask 2 FULL or Recreational members of the Club (16 years of age & over) to propose and second your application form and return the form in a sealed envelope to :-

**ALL** new members must pay a one off **joining fee of £3.00** in addition to the membership fee. This is also payable by members who have failed to renew their membership by the due date (30th November). Cheques should be made payable to MISC. Please do not send cash in the post.

The Club season runs from **February** each year irrespective of when you join. Using this form to join will take your membership up to the **end of January 2018**. If you want to know more about the Club we will be happy to answer all your questions at any Club session.

When 4 or more family members (at the same address) join the club the least expensive of the memberships is free.
